

PRODUCT PACKAGING TAKE-BACK POLICY FOR ENVI-GEL 365 COOL+

1. Policy Statement

Envicom Pte. Ltd. is committed to reducing environmental impact through responsible packaging management and the promotion of circular economy practices.

As part of this commitment, Envicom implements a take-back policy for the packaging of ENVI-GEL 365 COOL+, which utilizes polypropylene (PP) bags and carton boxes packaging, to encourage reuse, recycling, and proper waste handling.

2. Scope of Application

This policy applies to:

- All packaging materials associated with ENVI-GEL 365 COOL+, including:
 - All polypropylene (PP) bag packaging used for ENVI-GEL 365 COOL+
 - Carton boxes (paper-based packaging)
- Customers, distributors, and project partners who purchase and use the product
- Selected project sites or regions where take-back logistics are feasible

3. Packaging Description

The packaging material for ENVI-GEL 365 COOL+ consists of:

- Polypropylene (PP) woven bags
- Carton boxes

The material is recyclable and may be repurposed through appropriate recycling channels.

4. Take-Back Program

Envicom offers a voluntary take-back program under the following framework:

- Customers are encouraged to segregate and collect used PP bags and carton boxes after product use
- Packaging should be emptied and kept in reasonably clean condition (free from excessive contamination)
- Envicom may arrange collection directly or through authorized partners, depending on location and project scale

Alternative options may include:

- Drop-off at designated collection points

5. Responsibilities

Envicom Pte. Ltd.:

- Provide guidance on proper handling and segregation of used packaging
- Facilitate collection, where applicable
- Ensure that collected packaging is directed to recycling or responsible recovery processes

Customers/Users:

- Segregate and store used PP bags and carton boxes appropriately
- Ensure packaging is not mixed with hazardous or non-recyclable waste
- Coordinate with Envicom for collection or approved disposal routes

6. Recycling and Recovery

Collected PP bags and carton boxes will be:

- Recycled into secondary plastic materials, where feasible, or
- Sent to authorized recycling facilities for proper material recovery

Envicom prioritizes partnerships with licensed recyclers to ensure environmentally sound management.

7. Limitations

The take-back program is subject to:

- Geographic and logistical feasibility
- Minimum quantity requirements for collection (if applicable)
- Condition of returned packaging

Envicom reserves the right to decline collection if the packaging is heavily contaminated or unsuitable for recycling.

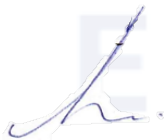
